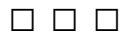
**Angel Shaw** of Rape Response Services has announced that RRS and the Bangor Police Department are bringing radKIDS to Bangor in April and May.

The radKIDS program "is the national leader in children's safety education, and provides the only holistic, practical and realistic life skills safety program available for children and parents today," the RRS release says.

Classes will be conducted for children ages 8-12 from 6 to 8 p.m. in April, and for children 5-7 from 1 to 3 p.m. in April and May, at the Police Department.
